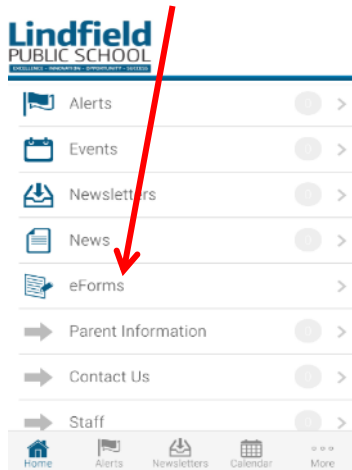
## Absentee Notification

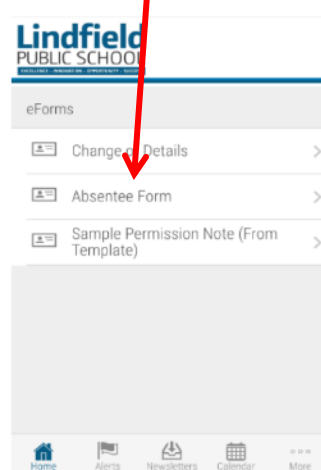
