#### Mother's Day Breakfast

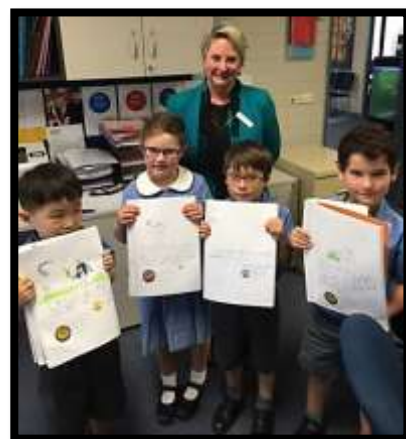

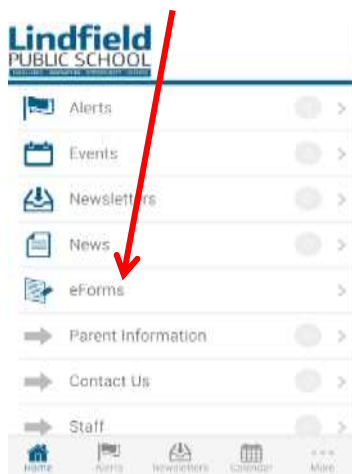

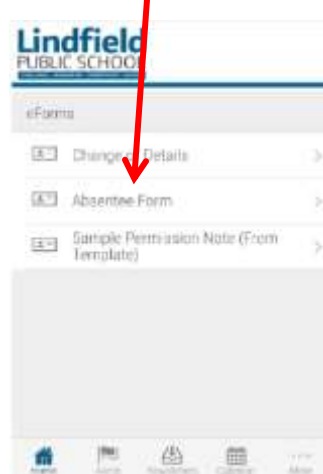
