INTRODUCTION OF NEW FINANCE SYSTEM

Dear Parents and Carers

Lindfield Public School will transition to the new NSW Public Schools' finance system and a new bank account on **5 September 2016**.

To ensure a smooth transition, there will be changes to the way we accept payments from parents and carers.

1. **EFTPOS payments:** We will not be able to accept EFTPOS payments between **29 August** and **5 September 2016**. Please ensure that you have made any outstanding EFTPOS payments before **29 August, 2016**. From **6 September 2016**, EFTPOS payments will be accepted as before.
2. **Cash and cheque payments:** Between **31 August 2016** and **5 September 2016**, we will also not be able to accept payments by cash or cheque as we prepare to close our current bank account and transition to the new one. Please ensure that you have made any outstanding cash or cheque payments before **31 August 2016**. From **6 September 2016**, cash and cheque payments will be accepted as before.
3. **Online payments:** Between **27 August 2016** and **4 September 2016**, we will also not be able to accept online payments as we prepare to close our current bank account and transition to the new one. Please ensure that you have made any outstanding online payments before **27 August 2016**. From **5 September 2016**, online payments will be accepted as before.




Stewart House Blue Mufti Day







It has been a crazy few months touring around QLD, NSW and ACT with our children's choir performing at many schools and churches. I have to admit it was quite challenging however I have loved meeting so many new people and it has been so encouraging to see people's generosity. THANK YOU to

everyone who supported our events and gave generously! We could not have achieved this amazing goal without your help!

I had many proud mummy moments watching the children shine on stage as they shared their gifts of singing, dancing and drumming and told of their personal stories. Each of the kids has a different highlight, but some include flying a plane (Isaac), going to the cinemas, ten pin bowling, seeing the city of Sydney (Harbour Bridge and Opera House), going to Parliament House, Dubbo Zoo and of course swimming at the beach.
