Safety First and Respecting our Neighbours

Several disturbing incidents and near-misses have been reported recently on Grosvenor Rd and Gladstone Parade. They have been due to our parents double parking, u-turning over the crossing, parking in 'No Parking' and 'No Stopping' zones. Some parents have been calling students across the road to their car instead of ensuring children cross at the supervised pedestrian crossing. When challenged about these incidents, some parents have reacted with inappropriate language and gestures in front of our students. This affects the reputation of our school. Please put the safety of our students first and park in designated areas even if it means walking further. Thank you for your cooperation.

The carparks are **STRICTLY** for staff use from 7:30 am until 4:30pm. A near-miss occurred this week when a parent pulled into the Grosvenor Rd carpark around 8.50am and then reversed quickly down the driveway. A parent reported that children were almost hit. This behaviour is unacceptable. The Council Rangers have been contacted and will issue fines when they patrol our school surrounds in the near future.

A justified complaint has been received about students and parents trespassing on private property. Please do not use the complex at 1-3 Eton Rd/3-11 Burleigh St as a thoroughfare. This is private property and not to be used as a right of way to our school. Please respect our neighbours and use the public footpaths.

Students in KM showcased their Austin's Butterfly artwork and entertained us with their rendition of 'Rockin' Robin' at last week's assembly. Well done KM!





Term 4 Accounts

Kindergarten Ethics Notes

Kindergarten Ethics notes for 2018 were sent out last week and are due Wednesday 29 November to Mrs Cornell's office. Students who do not attend Scripture classes in NSW public schools can attend Ethics classes as an alternative to Non-Scripture. The Primary Ethics curriculum is inquiry based. Children use dialogue and discussion, learning how to think about ethical matters through the give-and-take of reasoned argument. Children who currently attend 'Non Scripture' will have priority access to this class over others who might want to join by opting out of their current Scripture class. This is according to Department of Education Policy.

Seeking Ethics Teachers for 2018

Lindfield Public School **urgently** needs new volunteer Ethics teachers. Without new volunteer teachers, LPS will not be able to provide classes to all children who have nominated to do Ethics instead of Scripture or non-Scripture. Ethics teachers need to:

- Be comfortable working with, and be able to engage, with children
- Have an interest in helping children think about ethics using the Primary Ethics curriculum
- Have an open-minded, inquiring outlook
- Have excellent communication skills
- Be available to teach a class on Tuesday mornings at 10:30 – 11am.
