## Maintenance and Buildings

For the rest of the term our school will be undergoing an extensive maintenance program funded by the Department of Education as part of the backlog maintenance funding. External painting and roof repairs on some buildings will be carried out. For this reason, you may see workmen at school on weekends and during the week. Weather permitting, this weekend they will commence water pressure cleaning in preparation for painting. I am looking forward to our school looking freshly painted and having new gutters installed on some buildings.

The fence has been erected near the K-2 Toilets ready for the installation of the new demountable. This will be in place in time for the new school year.

## 3G Assembly

At Tuesday's assembly, 3G presented their artworks. They have been studying the artwork of Claude Monet, looking at the different styles and techniques he used in his artwork. Techniques included short brush strokes and the 'impasto' style which causes the eyes to blend the colours together on the canvas, thus creating an 'impression' for the viewer. The students created artworks based on his 'Water Lilies, 1906'; 'Japanese Bridge, 1896' and then created some portraits that looked at the way light was reflected off various objects outside.

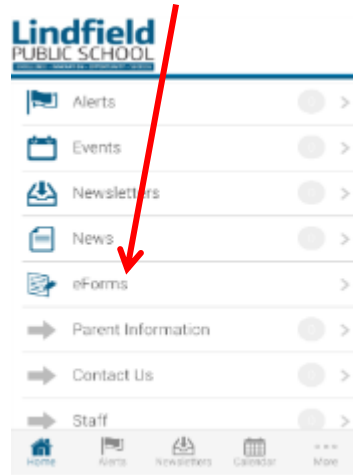

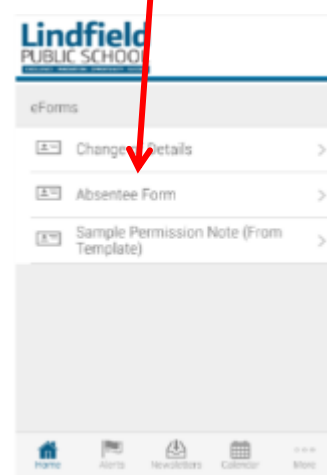

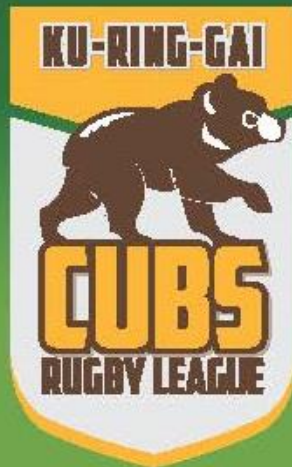
