We would like to thank all the staff that have done their best to keep the crossing a safe place to cross the road for most of 2019. We look forward to welcoming Mrs Ayuni tomorrow at 8:15am. Make sure to say hello and welcome her to her new role!

#### **Student Supervision and Safety Concerns**

Recently we have become concerned with the times students are being dropped at school and picked up in the afternoon. In the morning, students should arrive at school between 8:30am and 8:55am. Playgrounds are supervised from 8:30am and the school cannot accept responsibility for students before this time. Students are not permitted to arrive at school before 8:30am. Students who arrive at school after 9:00am must report to the front office accompanied by a parent/carer to be given a late arrival note. This note should be given to the class teacher.

In the afternoon, it is expected that students are collected from school promptly at 3:00pm. For our children's safety, it is expected that students in Kindergarten, Year 1 and 2 are collected from their classrooms. Teachers will take students to the front office if they aren't collected on time. Parents will then be required to sign the 'Late Pick Up' register in the front office and provide a reason for why they are late to pick up their child. If your child attends an after school activity, it is your responsibility to supervise your child until the activity commences. Once the activity has commenced, student supervision is the responsibility of the person or group organising the activity - not the responsibility of the school. Students must be supervised by their parent/carer after 3:00pm and are not permitted to remain unsupervised to wait for an afternoon tutorial or lesson. Thank you for cooperation in ensuring we all work together to keep our students safe.

# Swim Scheme 2019 Years 3-6 Students

### Term 3 Week 9 and 10

Monday 16 September to Friday 27 September

The Department of Education School Swimming and Water Safety Program is an intensive learn-to-swim program, which develops water confidence and provides students with basic skills in water safety and survival. The program is conducted over ten days. Each daily lesson is 45 minutes.

All Year 2 students will participate in this program. We encourage any Years 3-6 students who have not reached a satisfactory standard of water safety and survival skills, and are unable to swim 25m confidently unaided in deep water, to participate in the School Swimming and Water Safety Program. The program focuses on weak swimmers in Year 3 to 6, as well as students with special needs such as new arrivals in Australia and students with disabilities.

The cost of the program is \$30 and will take place at school.

This program is an excellent opportunity for students to improve their confidence and water safety skills.


#### Parent Information and Kindergarten Orientation Visits Thursday 7 November and Thursday 14 November 2019 from 9:30am to 11:00am

While the children are visiting the Kindergarten classrooms, there will be information sessions for parents/carers in the School Hall.




Also, our Senior Girls will compete in the playoffs against Summer Hill PS and Neutral Bay PS this Sunday down at St George Leagues. Go go Girls!
