Beginning of the Year Procedures for 2021

When students return next year, they will be placed in temporary or holding classes until we can ascertain our final numbers as numbers change over the holiday break. Once this is done, we can finalise the class structures and move into permanent classes. We expect this process to take several days. During this time, all children will be actively involved in lessons around road safety, friendships and anti-bullying as well as returning to the study of English, Maths, Science, PD/H/PE and Creative Arts. This year, teachers have already commenced planning for 2021. Next year, the Department of Education has nominated tow Staff Development Days to commence the school year. These will be Wednesday 27 January and Thursday 28 January (pupil free). We look forward to seeing students from Year 1-6 return on Friday 29 January. Students in Years 3-6 should wear Sports Uniform. I will keep you informed of the COVID-19 restrictions that will be in force for 2021 once they have been announced. At this stage we will be continuing our 'Kiss and Drop' procedures and 2:50pm entry onto school grounds to pick up students.

The Senior Girls Lindfield 1 Cricket team was presented with their patches for being Runners Up in the Summer PSSA competition. Well done girls!



Classes 2021

As the year is drawing to a close, we are currently planning for next year. At this stage, our numbers are changing daily and we have dropped to around 800 students enrolled for 2021 which would require us to form 30 or 31 classes. These classes may include composite classes, job share classes and single grade classes. Class structure is determined by the staffing formula provided by the Department of Education. The placing of children into new classes is a complex and time-consuming process as each year we strive to ensure that we have well-balanced classes. Classes at Lindfield PS are not graded academically except for the Stage 3 Extension class. When forming balanced classes, many factors are taken into consideration: gender; academic ability; special needs such as learning support, English as an additional language or dialect, behavioural and social needs; medical needs and learning behaviours. Teachers also request students to identify friendships in an attempt to place each child with a nominated friend in their class. We do not take parent requests for teachers or for students to be placed together. Please respect the teachers' professionalism as they place students in a class that will best meet their educational needs. Speak to your child's class teacher or contact me directly should you have any educational concerns regarding your child's placement.

Student Progress Reports

The Semester 2 Student Progress Reports were sent home yesterday. Please check your child's bag if you haven't seen your copy yet. This year we have adopted a new report format that includes a tick box scale for Areas of Learning in English and Maths in addition to the other Key Learning Areas. These are averaged out to give an overall achievement grade for that Key Learning Area or subject. The General Comment at the end of the report gives further information about achievements, areas to develop, social skills and learning behaviours. Please celebrate the successes with your child and set goals for the future.







This is a new (paid) role whose key responsibilities are to work effectively with the P&C and the Band Committee to:

- Maintain relevant band records including enrolments, equipment and tutor allocations;
- Ensure that the band program is delivered in accordance with its objectives, budget, and the requirements of the school
- Arrange for up-to-date band information and payment processes on P&C website.
- Organise events including the annual Music Camp and band-related fundraising activities.
- Ensure that processes are in place for musical equipment to be maintained.
- Work with service providers and suppliers and assist in resolving issues; and
- Work with parent volunteers who assist in running various aspects of the program.

The position will suit someone with excellent communication skills, attention to detail, strong customer service and problem solving skills. Experience working with volunteers will also be well regarded. The successful applicant will report regularly to the P&C Executive and the Band Committee and work closely with them as well as with school staff, including the Principal and Deputy Principals.

You must have good computer skills, including the ability to use Excel.

While the role is generally flexible, and may be able to be largely performed on a work-from-home basis, there will be peak periods (such as the beginning and end of the school year and the lead-up to Music Camp) when the number of hours of work will be greater than at other times of the year and when attendance at the school will be required.

Applications for student travel in 2021 opened from Monday 12 October 2020.

Students who require a School Opal card or travel pass for 2021 can now <u>apply</u> online. A new application should be submitted if a student is applying for a school travel pass for the first time or requesting an additional pass as a result of a new shared parental responsibility situation (e.g. joint custody).

Students who have changed school/campus, changed address, repeated a year or received an expiry notification from Transport for NSW for their school travel entitlement should re-apply or update their details.

*Applications must be completed by the student's parent or legal guardian if the student is aged under 16 years. Students 16 years and over must complete the application form themselves.

Where there is a change of distance eligibility based on a student's grade, the system will automatically update a student's entitlement if they meet the new criteria. If they do not meet the new eligibility criteria, they will receive an expiry notification via email.

Students who have an entitlement approved under a medical condition which is due to expire will receive a notification advising them to re-apply.

Term Bus Pass holders will receive a notification to re-apply.

If a student needs to update their information or re-apply, they should go online to https://apps.transport.nsw.gov.au/ssts/updateDetails

Applications need to be submitted before **31 December 2020** to ensure that current student entitlements are updated and their current entitlement/card remains valid. If their application is submitted after 31 December 2020, the system will automatically cancel an entitlement/card and a new one will need to be issued.

Students in the Opal network applying for a SSTS or Term Bus Pass entitlement for the first time will receive their card at their nominated postal address. Cards will be mailed out from January 2021.




