As mentioned in the Graduation Assemblies, only Year 6 parents and carers may form a guard of honour down Grosvenor Rd between the LAC driveway and the top gate near the Hall. Following a lap of honour around the school, the Year 6 students will leave the school grounds to parade up Grosvenor Rd and re-enter the school via the gate near the Hall. All other leavers will do a lap of honour around the school in a COVID-safe way where grades do not mingle. No parents may enter the school grounds as per the current Department of Education guidelines.

Today the staff was treated to a delicious (COVID-safe) lunch catered by our very own Canteen team. Many thanks to the P&C for putting on this event and for our special gifts. It was so good to be able to enjoy this meal with colleagues without having to prepare it. We feel valued by our community - thank you.



## Beginning of the Year Procedures for 2022

When students return next year, they will be placed in temporary or holding classes until we can ascertain our final numbers as numbers change over the holiday break. Once this is done, we can finalise the class structures and move into permanent classes. We expect this process to take only a few days. During this time, all children will be actively involved in lessons around road safety, friendships and anti-bullying as well as returning to the study of English, Maths, Science, PD/H/PE and Creative Arts. This year, teachers have already commenced planning for 2022. Next year, the Department of Education has nominated two Staff Development Days to commence the school year. These will be Friday 28 January and Monday 31 January (pupil free). We look forward to seeing **students from Year 1-6 return on Tuesday 1 February.** I will keep you informed of the COVID-19 restrictions that will be in force for 2022 once they have been announced.

## Classes 2022

As the year is drawing to a close, we are currently planning for next year. At this stage, our numbers are changing daily and we have dropped to around 740 students enrolled for 2022. The reduction in numbers is a result of many factors including changes to the intake (catchment) area; Lindfield Learning Village opening up to a defined catchment area; families moving to rural areas; as well as families moving interstate and overseas. At this stage we are entitled to form 28 classes. These classes may include composite classes, job share classes and single grade classes. Class structure is determined by the staffing formula provided by the Department of Education. The placing of children into new classes is a complex and time-consuming process as each year we strive to ensure that we have well-balanced

classes. Classes at Lindfield PS are not graded academically except for the Stage 3 Extension class. When forming balanced classes, many factors are taken into consideration: gender; academic ability; special needs such as learning support, English as an additional language or dialect, behavioural and social needs; medical needs and learning behaviours. Teachers also request students to identify friendships in an attempt to place each child with a nominated friend in their class. We do not take parent requests for teachers or for students to be placed together. Please respect the teachers' professionalism as they place students in a class that will best meet their educational needs. Speak to your child's class teacher or contact me directly should you have any educational concerns regarding your child's placement.




