NAPLAN Online - Years 3 and 5

Beginning on Wednesday 13 March, Years 3 and 5 will start their NAPLAN tests. All students will complete the Writing test on Wednesday. Year 3 will complete their Writing test on paper in their own classroom. Year 5 will complete the Writing test online in the computer rooms. We ask that all students bring headphones (not bluetooth) each day (with a headphone jack) to access the audio content of the tests. The tests cover skills in reading, writing, spelling, grammar and punctuation, and numeracy. The testing window will conclude on Monday 25 March. There is no need to prepare for these assessments. Please do your best to minimise worry and concern with your children and remind them that these are 'point in time' tests. The best way to prepare for these tests is to make sure all students get a good night's sleep and have a healthy breakfast before arriving at school on time. If students are absent on their test day, they will need to be 'caught up' when they return to school. All tests must be completed within the testing window.


