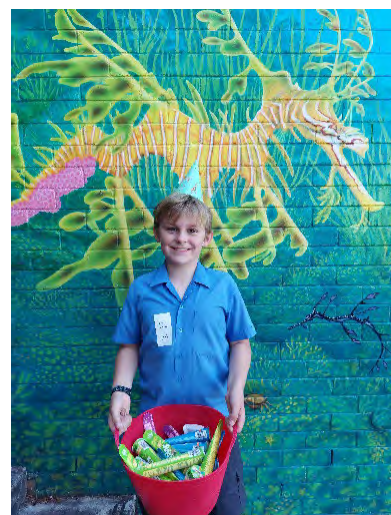
Helping can be as effortless as once a term!
